

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

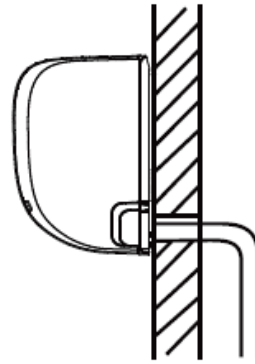
By default, the indoor unit drain hose is attached to the left-hand side of unit (when you're facing the back of the unit). However, it can also be attached to the right-hand side.

1. Attach the drain line to the end of indoor unit drain hose. Make sure the drain line fits firmly, otherwise cut the desired connector in center for proper fit.
2. Wrap the connection point firmly with waterproofing tape to ensure a good seal and to prevent leaks.
3. For the portion of the drain hose that will remain indoors, wrap it with foam pipe insulation to prevent condensation.
4. Remove the air filter and pour a small amount of water into the drain pan to make sure that water flows from the unit smoothly.

! NOTE ON DRAIN HOSE PLACEMENT

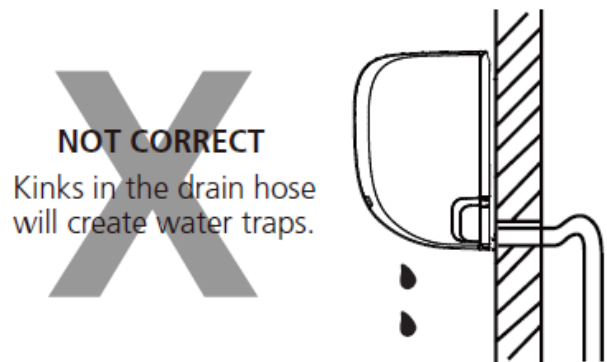
Make sure to arrange the drain hose according to

- ⊘ **DO NOT** kink the drain hose.
- ⊘ **DO NOT** create a water trap.
- ⊘ **DO NOT** put the end of drain hose in water or a container that will collect water.



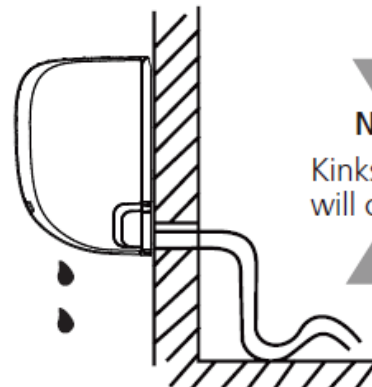
CORRECT

Make sure there are no kinks or dent in drain hose to ensure proper drainage.



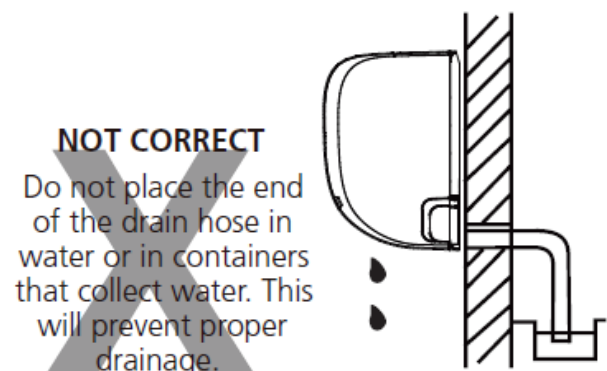
NOT CORRECT

NOT CORRECT

Do not place the end of the drain hose in water or in containers that collect water. This will prevent proper drainage.
